The Higher Secondary/Technical Higher Secondary/Art Higher Secondary First Year Improvement / Supplementary Examination of September 2012 will commence with effect from 17-09-2012 (Monday) as per the time table appended. The Examination will be conducted in all the Examination centers in Kerala and Lakshadweep provided for the conduct of First Year Higher Secondary Examination March 2012 and in the selected centre in the Gulf.

ELIGIBILITY

❖ Candidates who have appeared for all the six subjects at the First Year Higher Secondary Examination, March 2012 can register in this examination for upto three subjects for improving his / her scores in those subjects.

❖ Candidates who have registered for the First Year Higher Secondary Examination, March 2012, but could not attend the First Year Higher Secondary Examination, March, 2012 due to various reasons can register for all subjects for which they were absent. Such candidates in addition to registering for the absent papers can also register for improving the scores of upto three papers of the appeared subjects. For eg. a candidate who had appeared for four subjects at the First Year Higher Secondary Examination, March 2012 and was absent for the remaining two subjects can register for the two subjects for which he was absent and also register for improving the scores of any three subjects which he attended at the First Year Higher Secondary Examination, March 2012. A candidate who was absent for all six subjects at the First Year Higher Secondary Examination, March 2012 can register for all six subjects.

Note:

- Regular candidates who have appeared for all six subjects at the First Year Higher Secondary Examination, March 2012 or First Year Improvement Examination, September 2012 alone are eligible to register for the Plus Two Higher Secondary Examination, March 2013.
- ❖ Candidates admitted to the Second Year Higher Secondary course from other Boards / Institutions during 2012-2013 shall appear for all subjects in the Examination as lateral entry candidates. They shall undergo Continuous Evaluation in all six subjects of First Year Higher Secondary course. They shall be eligible for registering for the Second Year Higher Secondary Examination March 2013 only if they appear for the First Year Higher Secondary Examination in all subjects, at this Examination.
- ❖ Candidates who have registered for the First Year Higher Secondary Examination, March 2009 or March 2010 or March 2011 but did not appear for the same or subsequent First Year Higher Secondary Examinations and who had completed the Second Year Course can register for this Examination provided they have undergone Continuous Evaluation for all six subjects. (In the case of school-going candidates, they should have also completed the First Year Course by securing not less than 75% attendance).
- Candidates admitted to the Higher Secondary Course prior to 2008-2009 and who gained re-admission to the Second Year Higher Secondary Course during 2012-2013 shall register for this Examination for all six papers provided they have undergone CE

for all six subjects. Such candidates shall be eligible to register for the Second Year Higher Secondary Examination, March 2013 only if they have appeared for all six papers of First Year at this Examination.

- ❖ Candidates who have appeared for the Second Year Higher Secondary Examinations under Scheme -1 but failed to attain D+ grade or above for any of the subjects, can register for the First Year Papers of those subjects in this Examination. Such candidates can register for the Second Year papers of all failed subjects at the Higher Secondary Examination, March 2013 only if they have registered and appeared for the First Year papers of the failed subjects at this Examination.
- ❖ Candidates who became ineligible for higher studies in Scheme –I in the Higher Secondary Examination held in 2010, 2011 & 2012 should appear for both First Year & Second Year papers of the ineligible subjects. They should appear for the First Year papers of the ineligible subjects along with this Improvement Examination and the Second Year papers along with the Second Year March 2013 Examination.
- Note: (i) The eligibility in the concerned subject(s) of candidates coming under the above category will be determined by the TE scores attained by them at the First Year Higher Secondary Improvement Examination September 2012 and the Second Year Higher Secondary Examination March 2013 to which will be added the CE & PE scores obtained by them earlier in those subject(s). TE scores of First Year and Second Year Examination of the ineligible subjects obtained previously will not be carried forward for determining the eligibility in that subject(s). A candidate who became ineligible for a particular subject under Scheme-I of 2010, 2011 and 2012 of Second Year Higher Secondary Examinations will not be permitted to appear for the Second Year Higher Secondary Examination March 2013 of that subject if he has not appeared for the First Year Higher Secondary Improvement/Supplementary Examination September 2012 of that subject.
 - (ii) Candidates appearing for First Year Improvement examination in Biology should attend both Botany and Zoology papers.
 - (ii) Candidates who have attended all subjects in the First Year Higher Secondary Examination only shall be eligible to register for the subsequent Second Year Higher Secondary Examination.

SUBMISSION OF APPLICATIONS

Application duly filled in shall be submitted to the Principal of the school where the student is studying or registered for the March 2012 Examination along with prescribed fee. A passportsize photograph attested by the Principal should be pasted in the space provided in the application form. The candidates can have their application forms from their schools where they appeared for the Examination of March 2012 or from the School where they are studying.

The Principals of the respective school should register the candidates at their centre for First Year Improvement Examination, September 2012, online, through Department portal, **dhsekerala.gov.in**. The concerned school authorities should download the admission tickets of the candidates attending First Year Improvement Examination, September 2012 and distribute the same to the candidates atleast three days before the commencement of the Examination. The candidates on receipt of the admission tickets must scrutinize them and get the defect, if any rectified then and there. The notification is applicable to the Open School and the Private Registration Candidates also. Application form is common to all candidates. The

Principals of the parent school should receive the applications with enclosures, consolidate the datas, prepare the nominal roll and question paper statement of the candidates attending the Examination and upload the details through Department Portal before the last date fixed for the same.

EXAMINATION FEE FOR FIRST YEAR IMPROVEMENT/SUPPLEMENTARY EXAMINATION.

CANDIDATES OF GULF AND LAKSHADWEEP SCHOOLS

The candidates from the Gulf countries and Lakshadweep shall submit their application in the centre where they had registered for the First Year Higher Secondary Examination, March 2012. The parent schools shall upload the details of such candidates to the DHSE portal.

All candidates of the Gulf region should appear for the Examination at the The New Indian Model HSS, Dubai (Centre Code 15004). Candidates of Lakshadweep can appear for the Examination in the centres provided for the First Year Higher Secondary Examination, March 2012. The Principals of the parent school in Gulf shall sent the details of the students along with the Question Paper requirement to the Examination Centre well in advance so as to enable the Principal of the Examination Centre to consolidate the Question Paper requirement and upload the same before the last date prescribed for the same. The photograph of such candidates shall be attested by the school Principal. They shall also produce before the Principal of the Examination Centre their Admission Ticket of March 2012 Examination / Identity Card issued from the School where they have studied. The Examination Centres are allowed in Lakshadweep for the First Year Improvement / Supplementary Examination on condition that the entire responsibility regarding this examination will rest with the office of the Director of Education, Administration of the Union Territory of Lakshadweep. The centre in the Gulf is permitted on condition that the whole expense for conducting this exam shall be before equally by all the schools presenting candidates for this exam.
