The Principals of the schools concerned shall submit 3 copies of duly filled in proforma nominating the eligible Higher Secondary School teachers for consideration of awarding the national award. The nominations shall be recommended by the Head of local body (Corporations/Municipalities/Panchayats) concerned and shall be submitted to the Regional Selection Committee before 28/01/2015 in the following manner.

A character and conduct certificate vouching the faultless antecedents and absolute integrity of the applicant from the Principal of the school concerned shall be attached along with the filled in nomination form.

While recommending the teachers, the Principals are compulsorily & categorically state (in a separate sheet) the SPECIAL OR UNIQUE attribute of the teachers on the basis of which their names have been recommended (in the case of Principals, the statements shall be issued by the RDD concerned). Lack of such statement shall render the nomination of teacher (s) ineligible for consideration.

The Regional Selection Committee shall impartially identify the eligible teachers from among the nominations received and recommend only THREE names from each region to the State Selection Committee before 09/02/2015




The Government of India, Ministry of Human Resource Development, Department of School Education & Literacy implements a Scheme of 'National Award to Teachers' as per which teachers from all over the country are selected for National Awards. The following categories of teachers are eligible for award under this Scheme:

- (i) Recognized Primary and Secondary School Teachers of States/UTs/Organisation;
- (ii) Sanskrit Teachers of Sanskrit Pathshalas and Tolls run on traditional lines;
- (iii) Arabic/Persian Teachers of Madrasas run on traditional lines;
- (iv) Teachers of CBSE affiliated schools;*
- (v) Teachers of CISCE affiliated schools;
- (vi) Teachers of CTSA affiliated Schools; and
- (vii) Teachers who promote the education of children with disability in regular schools by States/UTs/Organisations and other school system.

*The teachers recommended by CBSE should be other than those who have already been covered under the allocated quota for States/UTs/Organisations

2. The States/ UTs/Organisations wise quota for National Awards is given at Annexure-I...

- The 15 awards are reserved for Sanskrit Teachers of Sanskrit Pathshalas and Tolls and 5 awards for Arabic/Persian Teachers of Madrasas which cannot be allocated State-wise due to their limited number. Selection of teachers for these awards will, therefore, be made out of all the names that would be recommended by various States/Union Territories. At least two names may be recommended for these categories of teachers. From past experience, it is noticed that recommendations for these awards are not adequate. You are, therefore, requested to make special efforts to locate suitable SANSKRIT AND ARABIC/PERSIAN TEACHERS OF INSTITUTIONS RUN ON TRADITIONAL LINES SO THAT THE AWARDS DO NOT LAPSE. There are a large number of traditional Pathshalas/Tolls/Madrasas functioning in different parts of the country. However, since they may be functioning in an informal way or do not come to the notice of the Education authorities, special efforts need to be made to identify them and recommend their teachers for the National Awards, if they fulfill the necessary conditions.
- 4. It has been noticed that Sanskrit/Arabic/Persian teachers working in regular schools are generally not considered for National Award by the States due to a misunderstanding that such teachers would be eligible for awards from out of the 15 and 5 awards set apart for Sanskrit and Arabic/Persian Teachers of traditional Pathshalas and Madrasas. It is requested that Sanskrit and Arabic/Persian teachers working in regular Primary/Secondary schools should also be considered for National Award under the categories of Primary and Secondary school teachers.
- 5. You are also requested to give suitable representation to lady teachers while making your recommendations as it has been noticed that sufficient number of lady teachers are not recommended by the States. It may be noted that for class room teachers only 15 years of regular teaching experience is required, while for Principals/Headmasters 20 years of regular teaching service is required. However, for the Special award category, in case of teachers, 10 years of regular teaching experience and for Principals/Headmasters, 15 years of regular teaching experience is required.
- 6. While recommending the teachers, the State Committee/Central Award Committee are to compulsorily and categorically state the SPECIAL OR UNIQUE attribute of each teacher on the basis of which their names have been recommended. Lack of such information may render the teacher(s) ineligible for the award.

- A brief citation is required to be attached for teachers being recommended under the categories for special awards. If no suitable candidate is recommended, the allocated special awards shall not be transferred to general category. The other eligibility conditions as also the selection procedure will remain unchanged. Deserving teachers should, therefore, be encouraged in the interest of education by recommending sufficient number of such teachers who may themselves have disabilities and also those who have done commendable work for education of children with disabilities.
- (i) A copy of the minutes of the meeting of the State/UTs/Organisation Selection Committee finalising the recommendations may also invariably be sent, in original duly signed by all committees members. This is important and may please be noted for compliance.
- (ii) It may be reiterated that complete information as per the proforma is to be sent. There must be no deviation from the prescribed proforma. In case incomplete information is received, the recommendations will not be processed.
- Kindly acknowledge receipt of this letter and ensure that your recommendations must reach this Ministry as early as possible and in any case not later then 31st January, 2015 positively. I shall be grateful if the soft copy of the recommendation of the State Selection Committee along with enclosures may be sent through email at gaya prasad@nic.in and jalam.edu@nic.in.
- 9. It has been observed in the past that some 'States/UTs/Organisations send recommendations much after the last date for receipt causing unnecessary delay in the finalization of awards. It is, therefore, reiterated that nominations in the prescribed proforma only must be sent in time so as to ensure that the awards are finalized and necessary action is taken for their distribution on 5th September, 2015.

As per scheme of national award to teachers, teachers who are teaching upto class VIII should be considered in the category of Primary teachers and those teaching classes IX to XII in the category of Secondary school teachers.

2. As per the state wise allocation of National Awards, the total awards alloted to Kerala is 16 (sixteen) which are apportioned as given below:

- 4. Government have examined the matter in detail and are pleased to accord sanction for allotting three National Awards, out of the seven awards earmarked for standards 9 to 12, to Higher Secondary School Teachers from the academic year 2012-13 onwards. The detailed process of selection of Higher Secondary School Teachers for the National Awards is attached herewith.

NATIONAL AWARD TO HIGHER SECONDARY SCHOOL TEACHERS THE SELECTION PROCESS

Total awards earmarked for Higher Secondary sector is only three (3 only).

LCONDITIONS OF ELIGIBILARY OF TEACHERS FOR CONSIDERATION FOR THE AWARDS

- L. Higher, Secondary School Teachers with at least 15 years regular teaching experience in the Govt. or Aided Schools shall only be considered to granting national award.
- 2. Retired teachers who have served a part of the calendar year (at least 1 months i.e. up to $31^{\rm st}$ March in the year to which the National Award relates) may be considered if they are otherwise eligible for being enlisted.
- 3. Teachers whose names were recommended in the previous years can be considered afresh if they fulfill all other parameters prescribed to purpose.
- 4. Only those teachers possessing the requisite years of teaching experience, as mentioned at Sl. No.1 above, on 31st December of the preceding year of the award, will be eligible to be considered for the award.

II. MAIN YARDSTICKS FOR IDENTIFYING OUTSTANDING TEACHERS TO BE RECOMMENDED FOR NATIONAL AWARD

- 1. His/her reputation in the society
- 2. His/her academic efficiency and desire for its improvement.
- 3. His/her quality and effectiveness of class room transaction.
- 4. His/her acceptability as a teacher among children of the school.
- 5. Percentage of result in the subject taught by him/her.
- 6. His/her genuine interest in the subject taught and love for children.
- 7. His/her involvement in the social life of the community and
- 8. His/her ability to motivate children to fulfill their aims and ambitions.

III. PROCEDURE FOR SELECTION

1. No teacher shall be asked of permitted to apply for the award. The eligible teachers shall be impartially identified and recommended by the Regional Selection Committee to the State Selection Committee.

- 2. Initial selection shall be made at the Regional level by a Real Selection Committee from amongst the names recommended the Principals local authorities such as Corporation. Made we appropriate of the Region Committee by the primary selectors on the basis of the leadars' record of work and the yardsticks as listed at the serial No. It shows
- 3. The Regional Selection Committee will scrittinize recommendation of the primary selectors and recommend 1 had a from each Region (as of now the total number of regions of High Secondary is 3) to the state selection committee. Thus a total number, ie., 3 each from 3 regions, will come for the consideration of the State Selection Committee.
- 4. The State Selection Committee shall scrutinize and silt and recommendation of the 3 Regional Selection Committees of recommend to the State Government two names for each aware allotted to the Higher Secondary Sector. The names of leasts selected by the State Committee shall be arranged in order of media before they are recommended to the State Government.
